

Thick & Soft Ribbed Scarf with Wood Toggle



Knit Your Own Kit! Materials:

- 90 yards Corriedale wool, organic hand dyed & spun yarn
- 90 yards commercial yarn
- Wooden toggle with support button for closure

Gauge: 11 rows and 6 stitches=4"

Finished size: 5" wide, 34" long with size 13 needles.

Please check your gauge!



EASY PATTERN! Includes wooden toggle & support button.

SKILLS: Knit/purl rib, slipped stitches, cast on, bind off.



Instructions:

With one strand of Corriedale yarn and 1 strand of commercial yarn held together, cast on 20 stitches.

Row 1: K3, [P2, K3] 3 times to end

Row 2: P3, {K2, P3} 3 times to end.

Row 3: Slip first stitch purlwise with yarn in front, K2, [P2, K2} 3 times to end.

Row 4: Slip first stitch knitwise with yarn in back, P2, [K2, P3] 3 times to end.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until scarf reaches 34" long (approx 90 rows). Bind off in rib.

Attach toggle and support button 6" in from end. Plastic button should be on the underside and the toggle on top. Fold other end of scarf over and push toggle through knitted stitches to secure.

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
