

Squid Scarf! Calamari Cowl!



Materials:

- Yarn and the appropriate size crochet needle for the yarn weight.
- A few buttons for eyes (optional)
- Sewing needle

Finished size: Depends on you! Legs/tentacles should be long enough to wrap around your neck.

Gauge: Not important.

FAST & EASY PATTERN!

Finish your scarf in an evening.

SKILLS: Chain, half double crochet, crochet in the round or sewing on buttons (optional).



Make Legs:

Chain a length for a leg (or tentacle). Skip 2 chains and hdc in each stitch to the end. Chain 2, turn and hdc one more row (2 hdc rows total); Tie off.

Repeat for additional legs. Samples shown have 5 legs but you could have 8 for an octopus. All legs do not need to be the same length or made with the same yarn.

Make Body:

Chain a width for the squid body, wide enough to attach all legs. *Chain 2, turn, hdc in each stitch to end.* Repeat from * to * for 3-4 rows then decrease one stitch at end of each row.

To make curved top, end when 3 or 5 stitches remain. To make pointy top, end when one stitch remains. Attach legs to bottom, weave in ends. For eyes, add buttons or crochet in a circle and sew on.

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
